- ⇒ To self register, go to <http://www.eel.nhs.uk> and click “Register for OpenAthens”. Please do this from an NHS Computer.
- ⇒ Complete the form and click Submit. Make a note of your Username.
- ⇒ Check your Email Inbox for an activation email from EduServ Athens.
- ⇒ Click the link in this email and follow the instructions to choose a suitable password and activate your account.
- ⇒ Your Athens login is now ready to use & can be used on any computer—home or work.

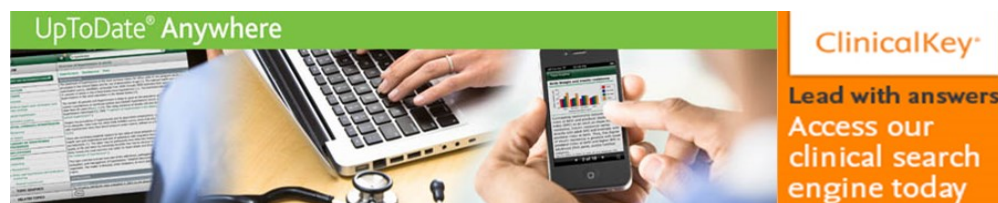
Introduction to Critical Appraisal
