There are two ways to leave us a gift in your Will:

1. Pecuniary gift - you can choose to give a gift of a fixed amount of money
2. Residuary gift - you can choose to leave a share, or the whole, of what is left in your estate once you have provided for your loved ones

If you have already made a Will

If you have already made a Will, but would like to leave a gift to us to support the Hospital, you can do so by making a simple addition to your existing Will. This is called a codicil. By adding this supplement to your will you can include new instructions and delete old ones without having to go through the task of revoking the whole Will.
